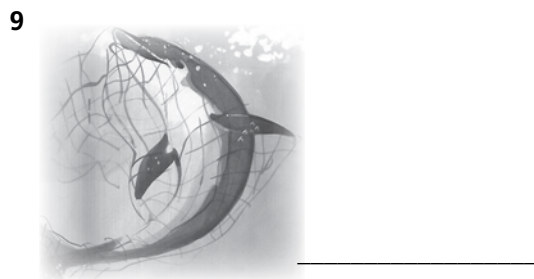
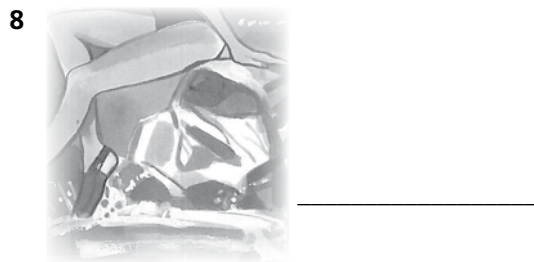
Put the events in the order they happen in the story. The first is 1.

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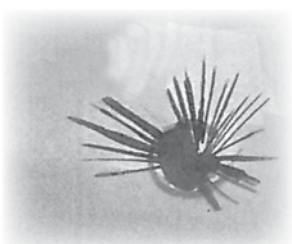
